

Hello.

We will be doing the free pattern from Studio 180 entitled “Freelance” that is in the Wedge Star ruler package. You will need this ruler for class. I suggest a Omni Grip for the back of the ruler also.

I have given you 2 sizes to try, a 9” block or a 12” block.

For the **9”** blocks, you will need the following:

Dark fabric - .625 yard

Medium Fabric - .375 yard

Light Fabric - .25

Background fabric - .625

For the **12”** blocks, you will need the following:

Dark Fabric – 1 yard

Medium Fabric - .375

Light fabric - .50

Background fabric – 1 yard.

These measurements are exact and do not account for any extra. You can decide your degree of comfort. You will need more fabric for the inner and outer borders.

9” inner border - .50 yard for 4 strips at 3.5”

9” outer border - .75 yard for 4 at 6.5

12” inner border - .50 yard for 4 strips at 3.5

12” outer border -

Please cut the following:

9” blocks

Dark fabric:

2- 2.5” strips – for the Diamonds

1 – 3.5” strip for the Small wedges

1 – 5.5” strip for the Large Wedges

1 – 4” strip for Corners

Medium Fabric

1 – 2.5” strip for the Diamonds

2 – 4” strips for the Corners

Light Fabric

2 – 5.5” strip for Large Wedges

Background Fabric

2 – 3.5” strips for Small Wedges

2 – 5.5” strips for Large Wedges

12” Blocks**Dark fabric:**

2 - 3” strips – for the Diamonds

1 – 4.25” strip for the Small wedges

1 – 7” strip for the Large Wedges

1 – 4.75” strip for Corners

Medium Fabric

1 – 3” strip for the Diamonds

2 – 4.75” strips for the Corners

Light Fabric

2 – 7” strip for Large Wedges

Background Fabric

2 – 4.25” strips for Small Wedges

3 – 7” strips for Large Wedges

Please make sure you label all of your strips so you know which ones we are using at a particular time.
