- Outreach Members reach out to our community to share quilting skills with youth and the non-quilting community.

- Comfort Quilts Members make lovely quilts and throws from donated fabrics and services. The finished quilts are given to programs within our area that help children, teens, and adults in need.
- Retreats Each fall and spring we
 offer a retreat to our members. Retreats are a time for members to quilt
 "without distraction" if they so choose.
